

2018 YUBA-SUTTER FAIR

NEW GUIDEBOOK CHANGES (LIVESTOCK)

1. Leaders must turn in Ear Tag Logs & Photographs of Animals within 5 days of tagging deadline listed in the Guidebook. They must be accurate and complete.
2. Vet check will be in the North Parking Lot. Any animal not passing Vet Check will be removed from trailer and penned in the parking lot (if multiple animals in trailer) and not allowed on grounds. After dropping other animals you will go back around and pick up the animal that did not pass vet check.
3. Vet Clearance Forms will be issued for animals that pass vet check. Market Animals will be required to turn this form in at the scale when weighing in. Breeding Animals are required to turn their Vet Clearance Form into the Auction/Livestock Office as soon as animals are in pens.
4. Vet will be checking Market Lambs and Market Goats for their milk teeth. If Market Lamb does not have milk teeth it will be disqualified and sent home. Market Goats must have milk teeth in normal positions and no permanent teeth showing at that time. Any Market Goat having lost any of its milk teeth will be disqualified and sent home.
5. If animals are tagged as back-up animals they must be entered and fees paid. (If you tag 3 back-up animals you must enter all 3)
6. There will be a deduction from Auction Checks of Exhibitors who are selling Market Lambs of \$2.50 for EID Ear Tags. Superior Farms (our processor) is requiring an EID Ear tag on all Market Lambs brought to their facility. In 2019, Market Goats will also be required to have the EID Ear tag.
7. Speckle/Brockle/White Face Market Lambs must submit pictures of both sides of shorn face and ears. Pictures are required at the time of the entry to determine eligibility. Livestock Superintendent has final determination on eligibility.
8. Speckle/Brockle/White Face Market Lamb Champions are eligible for Champion Drive, but will not sale with Champions.
9. Market animals must be tagged prior to doing online entries. The ear tag (YSF tag number must be accurate and on entry for entry to be complete with the exception of Poultry & Rabbits.
10. **NEW FOR 2019** Market Beef will be required to be slick shorn.
11. Breeding Ewes cannot be tagged and entered as a backup market lamb.
12. Breeding Gilts cannot be tagged and entered as a backup market hog.
13. Breeding Does cannot be tagged and entered as a backup market meat goat.
14. Lambs and Meat Goats may be braced, but they must have all 4 feet on the ground when showing.
15. Meat Goat must be shown with a choke collar or chain.
16. ARBA Show – This is a carry on show. You will bring your rabbits the day of the show and remove them when the show is complete. Animals must be received and in place by 9:30 am. Thursday, August 3, 2018. No rabbits will be allowed to enter the grounds after 9:00 am. The gate will open at 7:00 am.
17. A Complete Entry includes the following forms: Exhibitors Code of Practice Form, NEW Livestock Signature Page, Credential Form, If applicable Bred and Fed Affidavit, Bred and Owned Affidavit, Equine Lease, Horse Show Release must be turned into the fair office. Also, don't forget to enter your Still Exhibit and bring to the fair as per the Still Exhibit Schedule. This entry must be judged and displayed as this is requirement to show livestock.

18. Pass/Credential Policy: Livestock Exhibitors must purchase individual credentials. Credentials must be purchased by June 29, 2018. We will allow them to be purchased June 30, 2018 thru July 6, 2018 with a \$25 late fee. NO CREDITIALS WILL BE SOLD AFTER JULY 6, 2018.
19. Exhibitors participating a year out of high school and are not eligible to show in FFA or 4-H are not eligible to show as an Independent Exhibitor.
20. **NEW for 2018 FFA Exhibitors will pick up their Auction Checks at the Fair Office.**
21. Auction checks will be available August 17, 2018. FFA, 4-H & Independent Exhibitors will pick up their checks from the Fair Office. Livestock Auction Checks must be picked up and cashed by January 2, 2019. No funds will be available and check will be VOID after January 2, 2019 and monies will be forfeited to the contingency fund. There will be a \$35.00 fee for Stop Payment, if a replacement check is issued prior to January 2, 2019.
22. **ALL** premium checks will be available August 17, 2018.
23. **RV/Trailer Space - \$300.00** (includes power, water & one (1) parent wristband). Limit **110** spaces.
Tent Space - \$100.00 (includes power and water & one (1) parent wristband) Limit 4 spaces.
24. RV's are limited to a maximum length of 36 feet depending on space availability. RV's will be measured as they arrive in the staging area, if the measured length does not match length stated on RV application you will be sent home with NO REFUND.
25. The roads around the barns and in the RV areas must be kept clear so that fire and emergency vehicles can drive through at any time. The minimum width of these roads is twenty (20) feet. No pop-ups or tents are allowed in front of RV's at the GARDEN HIGHWAY CAMPSITES as they block the fire lane and access to potential emergencies. **IF YOU DO NOT COMPLY WITH THIS YOU ARE JEOPARDIZING A RV SPACE IN THE FUTURE.**
26. Fair Management reserves the right to place RV's. We will do our best to accommodate you, but you may not always be in the same space every year.
27. **POSTPONED UNTIL 2019** – Livestock Exhibitors are required to do the Quality Assurance & Ethics Trainings every year.
28. Market Beef will be loaded out at 7:00 am on Sunday Morning. Exhibitor must be there to load their animals. Livestock Superintendent/Fair Staff will determine what truck you will load your animal on.
29. Junior Exhibit Release: All animals must remain on the Fairgrounds until the official release time. Beginning Sunday, August 5th at 9:00 am at the Auction Office there will be 80 Releases given out in a Lottery System with 20 per 1½ hour time slot. Once the Lottery time slots are full regular releases will be given out at 6:30 pm with release time beginning at 7:30 pm. So please load and remove your vehicle as soon as possible. Please watch for fair goers as the fair will be open at this time. This does not include RV's they will be released after Steer Trucks have left Sunday Morning until 9:30 am and after 7:30 pm. Staging will be on Second Street in front of the Levee District 1 Office. **DO NOT** stage on Garden Highway and block traffic. No animal may be removed from the grounds prior to the official release time without permission of the Livestock Superintendent or Fair Management. Due to limited access, trailers and other vehicles will be allowed access to the Fairgrounds per the Livestock Rules and Schedule. Fair Staff and Security will monitor and control the flow of traffic.
30. State Rule V. Protest 2 - All Protest must be accompanied by a deposit of **\$500.00** (cash, money order or certified check made payable to the fair). Note: The deposit will be returned if the protest is upheld. If the protest is upheld, the violator may be held liable for any portion of direct costs incurred by the fair in the course of the protest resolution. Failure to reimburse the fair shall be cause for disallowing future entries in any of the network of California Fairs.
