Yuba-Sutter Fair Junior Fair Board Information

WHAT IS THE JUNIOR FAIR BOARD? The Junior Fair Board of the 13th District Agricultural Association (Yuba-Sutter Fair) is a leadership-oriented program designed for the youth of the counties of Yuba and Sutter, consisting of representatives from local High Schools.

WHO CAN APPLY FOR THE JUNIOR FAIR BOARD? Any student who will be a **Junior** during the 2017-2018 school year, and is regularly attending High School in Yuba/Sutter Counties is eligible to serve on the Junior Fair Board. Members serve a term of two years. Applicants **DO NOT** have to be involved in 4-H or FFA to serve as a member of the Junior Fair Board. We would like the membership of the Board to include a variety of individuals from different backgrounds.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF JUNIOR FAIR BOARD MEMBERS? Junior Fair Board Members are expected to attend one Junior Fair Board meeting each month throughout the year, and serve on a standing sub-committee prior to the Yuba-Sutter Fair. Members will give feedback about fair events and work towards creating events and activities that will enhance our fair. Unexcused absences from three monthly meetings will result in termination of appointment. During the Fair, members will be expected to assist with Fair activities, as well as fulfill their committee responsibilities. Members are also expected to assist with other events the Yuba-Sutter Fair hosts throughout the year.

HOW DO YOU BECOME A JUNIOR FAIR BOARD MEMBER? Simply fill out the application on the attached page and submit it to the Fair Office, or mail to: Junior Fair Board, 442 Franklin Avenue, Yuba City, CA 95991

Please remember that this opportunity is limited to Yuba & Sutter High School students who will be Juniors during the 2017-2018 school year. Applications are due by **October 13, 2017**.

RULES

- Must attend a Yuba-Sutter High School (or home-school)
- Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must have Application completely filled out and signed
- Must commit to work during the week of the fair – often between the hours of 8am and 6pm.

EXPECTATIONS

We will place you in the area where you are needed most. You will not be able to pick and choose which areas or events you will be scheduled to work. (We will work around livestock and pageant events)

If you have an emergency, you need to contact the coordinator at least 2 hours prior to your shift if you are switching shifts with someone.

If there is a conflict (showing livestock, pageant, etc.) with your shift, you need to contact the coordinator at least 2 weeks prior.

If a Junior Fair Board member fails to show up for their shift, the member will be asked to relinquish remaining passes and they will be disqualified from applying to Junior Fair Board next year.
