## Guidelines:

- See Livestock Schedule for receiving/release of livestock and Schedule of Events for the Fair.
- All Local and State Rules apply.
- Ages 9 – 19.
- Open to Yuba and Sutter counties only.
- All riders must be enrolled in a Yuba-Sutter 4-H Horse Group.
- All riders must wear a helmet that meets ASTM/SEI standards while mounted at all times.
- The Fair 4-H Uniform is appropriate for all events: riding boots, white collared shirt, white pants belt and 4-H scarf or tie.
- Top two (2) riders in each class will qualify to go on to the 4-H State Horse Classic and State Fair. This show will qualify you for the 2020 4-H State Horse Classic and State Fair.
- Classes with less than three (3) riders may be combined or cancelled.
- Parents/Project Leaders will supervise their members and their mounts at all times.
- Must complete Release and Waiver of Liability Agreement and Equine Lease Agreement (if applicable).
  - Novice: participants who have never loped in any show (open, 4-H, breed, gymkhana, schooling, etc.) and meets one of the following criteria: first or second year showing under saddle (does not include lead line) at any show, OR first year in a 4-H horse project and is either 9 or 10 years old as of January 1, 2019.
  - Junior: participants ages 9-13 years old as of January 1, 2019.
  - Senior: participants ages 14-19 years old as of January 1, 2019.
