SHOW INFORMATION

1. The Show Management reserves the right to limit the number of entries. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Early entry is *highly recommended*.
2. The heifer shows will take place on Saturday, November 13th. Ring A will start at 9 a.m. Ring B will start at the conclusion of the first heifer division in Ring A.
3. The steer shows will take place on Sunday, November 14th. Ring A will start at 9 a.m. Ring B will start at the conclusion of the first steer division in Ring A.

GENERAL SHOW RULES

1. No smoking will be allowed in the barn area.
2. The fairgrounds reserves the right to remove any competitor or spectator for any conduct that reflects poorly on the event.
3. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by show management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal to show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.
4. The Show Management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
5. Ethical treatment of all animals and ethical conduct is expected by all exhibitors, parents, and fitters.
6. Any animal exhibiting signs of an infectious or unsightly condition will not be permitted to show.
7. Any animal that is deemed a safety hazard by show management will be disqualified with no refund.
8. No dogs will be allowed around the show ring area.
9. Out of State exhibitors must provide show management the appropriate health inspections and brand inspections at the time of check-in.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. Online Entries are available starting on Friday, September 24th
2. Entry due date is Monday, November 8th, 2021.
3. Entry Fees:
 - a. Heifer Show: \$45 per entry
 - b. Steer Show: \$45 per entry
 - c. Market Heifer Show: \$45 per entry
 - d. Beef Showmanship: \$20 per entry
 - e. Late Entry: Additional \$25 per entry (If received after November 8th.)
4. Late entries will be charged an additional \$25 per entry. Entries received after Monday, November 8th are considered late and must pay the late entry fee of \$25 per entry.

6. No refunds will be available.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

1. All Cattle may arrive on Friday, November 12th from 7 am – 7 pm.
2. All heifers must be in place and checked-in by 7:00 pm Friday, November 12th.
3. All Steers and Market heifers must be in place and checked-in by 6:00 pm on Saturday, November 13th
4. All animals must be removed by 10:00 pm on Sunday, November 14th.

STALLING:

1. Complimentary shavings will not be provided by the fairgrounds. Exhibitors may bring and utilize their own shavings. Shavings will be available for purchase at the show. Straw bedding will not be allowed.
2. Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning the stall area prior to departure.
3. There will be no pre-assigned stalls. Exhibitors may choose their own tie area on a first come-first served basis.
4. Show out of trailer spaces with electrical access are available for \$50 per site for the duration of the weekend. Must be purchased online at the time of entering the jackpot show. Show out of trailer spaces with electrical access will be pre-assigned and must be purchased online.
5. Show out of trailer spaces *without* electrical are available at no cost. These spaces are limited and are available on a first come first-served basis. Exhibitors showing out of their trailers **MUST** leave the area how you found it. CLEAN UP all shavings, trash, feed and manure from your area before departure.
6. Power is limited in the barns. Highly recommended to bring generators as an alternate source of power. Generators must be placed outside of the barns.

WEIGH-INS

1. All Steers, Market Heifers & Commercial Heifers must be weighed-in for weight classification.
2. Commercial Heifer, Steer & Market Heifer weigh-in's available on Friday, November 12th from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
3. Steer & Market Heifer Weigh in's available on Saturday, November 13th from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
4. Weight discrepancies must be decided before the animal leaves the scale.

RV CAMPING

1. RV Camping spaces are available on the fairgrounds.
2. The cost is \$50 per night for electrical and water hookups.
3. All RV campers must pre-register and pay online at the time of entering the jackpot show.
4. RV Camp Spaces will be pre-assigned.

HEIFER SHOW INFORMATION

1. CJLA Sanctioned Show.
2. Heifers are eligible to show in both Show A and Show B. You must enter each show if you wish to compete in both shows. The heifer shows will take place on Saturday, November 13th. Ring A will start at 9:00 a.m. Ring B will start at the conclusion of the first heifer division in Ring A.
3. Exhibitors must be 5 through 21 years of age as of January 1st, 2021.
4. All heifers must be in place and checked-in by 7:00 p.m. Friday, November 12th.
5. All registered heifers must be registered in the exhibitor's name. The registration papers must be presented at the time of check-in.
6. The registered heifer show will include the following breed classes: Angus, Hereford (Polled & Horned), Shorthorn, Charolais, Maine Anjou/Maintainer, Chi/Chi X, All Other Breeds (AOB).
7. The Commercial Heifer Show is for non-registered/grade heifers. Commercial Heifers must be weighed-in. The classes will be divided by weigh classification. Commercial Heifer weigh-in's will take place on Friday, November 12th from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The Champion Commercial Heifer is not eligible to compete for Supreme Champion Heifer. Heifers entered in the Commercial Heifer division are NOT eligible to compete in the market heifer show too.

STEER SHOW INFORMATION

1. CJLA Sanctioned Show.
2. Steers are eligible to show in both Show A and Show B. You must enter each show if you wish to compete in both shows. The steer shows will take place on Sunday, November 14th. Ring A will start at 9:00 a.m. Ring B will start at the conclusion of the first steer division in Ring A.
3. Exhibitors must be 5 through 19 years of age as of January 1st, 2021.
4. All Steers must be in place and checked-in by 6:00 pm on Saturday, November 13th.
5. All Steers must be weighed in for weight classification. Steer Weigh in's will take place on Saturday, November 13th from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
6. The steer show will have three divisions: Prospect, Progress & Market. Divisions & Classes will be divided by weight classifications after the weigh-in. Weight classes will be posted the morning of the show.
7. Official Breed/Color classification will be verified and determined at the scales during weigh-in.
8. All British Steers must be verified by their breed association registration paper at the time of weigh-in.
9. The steer show will offer three color divisions:
 - a. British (Registered Shorthorn, Angus, Hereford – to be shown together)
 - b. All Other Color (AOC)
 - c. Black/Black X

MARKET HEIFER SHOW INFORMATION

1. The Market Heifer Show is **NOT** a CJLA Sanctioned Show.
2. All Market Heifers must be in place and checked-in by 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 13th
3. All Market Heifers must be weighed in for weight classification. Market Heifer Weigh in's will take place on Saturday, November 13th from 4:00 pm to 6:00 p.m.
4. The Market Heifer show will not be broken by breed/color, ONLY by weight. There will NOT be a Market, Prospect or Progress Division. Only an overall Champion & Reserve Champion Market Heifer will be selected.
5. The Champion & Reserve Champion Market Heifers ARE eligible to compete for the Supreme Champion Market Animal.

SHOWMANSHIP INFORMATION

1. CJLA Sanctioned Show.
2. There will be two days of showmanship competition. You must enter each day if you wish to compete in both showmanship competitions.
3. Heifers and Steers are eligible to be shown in both days of the showmanship competitions.
4. Cattle Showmanship ages will be based on the age of the exhibitor as of January 1, 2021.
5. Age Divisions will include:
 - a. Pee Wee Beef Showmanship: Ages 8 and under
 - b. Junior Beef Showmanship: Ages 9-12
 - c. Intermediate Beef Showmanship: Ages 13-15
 - d. Senior Beef Showmanship: Ages 16-21
6. All exhibitors must show their own heifer or steer.
7. All animals showed in showmanship must be entered in a steer or heifer class by the same exhibitor.
8. Fitting is optional for showmanship.
9. The Saturday Showmanship competition will take place after the conclusion of the heifer show on Saturday.
10. The Sunday Showmanship competition will take place after the conclusion of the steer show on Sunday.
