Proceed to Gate 16 for the Health Inspection. Market Meat Chickens and Rabbits will be on display and penned in the barn in between the two beef barns. Turkeys will be displayed and penned in the North Barn.

12 pm Arrival Deadline for all Poultry & Rabbits. All Poultry & Rabbits must be in place.

12:30 pm – 1 pm Official Weigh-in of Market Meat Rabbits & Chickens. Weigh-in order will be in alphabetical order of all the Clubs & Chapters combined. Small Animal Barn.

1 pm – 3 pm Official Weigh-in of Market Turkeys (North Barn) Weigh-in order will be in alphabetical order of all the Clubs & Chapters combined.

3 pm Arrival Deadline for all Livestock. All livestock must be in place.

3 pm – 5 pm Official Health Check, Weigh-in & Classification Sheep Entries.
All Wether Sire & Dam entries must be weighed in and will take place at the conclusion of the market lamb weigh-in. All breeding sheep will be health checked at the scale staging area. Weigh-ins will take place at the Sheep Scales near the Sheep Barn. Weigh-in order will be in alphabetical order of all the Clubs & Chapters combined.
