

WELCOME TO THE YUBA – SUTTER FAIR

The Yuba-Sutter Fair is committed to offering a comfortable, safe and enjoyable experience for all our guests. Please assist us by showing common courtesy to fellow fair guests. Please be respectful of others. Do not use profanity or engage in unsafe, illegal or offensive behavior.

SUBJECT TO SEARCH POLICY

In order to ensure the safety and security of all staff and guests, any person entering the Yuba-Sutter Fairgrounds will be subject to search of their person and property upon entry. Proceeding past this point indicates your voluntary consent to be searched. Any person refusing to submit to a search may be denied access to the fairgrounds.

RESTRICTED OR PROHIBITED ITEMS

This list of items that can (and can't) be brought into the Fair, intended to enhance the comfort, safety and well-being of all our guests.

PERMITTED ITEMS (WITH RESTRICTIONS)

I. BAGS, PURSES OR DIAPER BAGS

- a. All bags are subject to search upon entry.

II. FOLDING CHAIRS

- a. If a disability requires you to sit frequently, you may bring a folding chair with the following restrictions:
- b. Chairs may not be used in the following locations: Carnival Area, Kids Zone, Area Venue, Blocking Vendor(s), Walkways, Doors, and/or Gates.
*You may not obstruct pedestrian traffic. If staff member or security personnel asks you to move your chair, please comply.

III. UMBRELLAS

- a. Umbrellas cannot be more than three feet in diameter. **Please do not use an umbrella in crowded areas or in arena venue.** We prefer you use a hat to shield yourself from the sun.

IV. FOOD AND BEVERAGE

- a. We offer a variety of Fair Food options from vendors and concession stands throughout our location. However, we understand that guests may need to bring outside food and drinks.
*As such snack, food, and/or drinks required for medical purposes or special dietary need, and baby food/baby formula are all permitted.
- b. All beverages must be in a factory-sealed container, meaning reusable containers such as sports water bottle, and sippy cups cannot contain beverages when you go through entrance security screening.

V. CAMERAS AND LENSES

- a. Preserving memories of your day at the Yuba-Sutter County Fair is important. And we encourage you to take lots of photos. But we do have some restrictions on where cameras and other photo-taking devices can and cannot be used:
 - Any photography activities that may be deemed a nuisance to the enjoyment of others are prohibited.
 - Any photography or recording activities are prohibited inside private areas (i.e. restrooms).

PROHIBITED ITEMS AND ACTIVITIES

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Upon reaching security screening any prohibited item(s) must be returned to your vehicle or disposed of prior to entry.

- I. Knives
- II. Tools
- III. Firearms or firearm replicas
- IV. Mace or other Chemical agents
- V. Flammable liquids or charcoal
- VI. Fireworks/firecrackers
- VII. Alcohol or any other type of alcoholic beverage
- VIII. Cannabis products of any kind
- IX. Illicit substances
- X. Laser pointers
- XI. Hard shell coolers/ice chests (plastic, metal, etc.) *exemption may be made for medical or infant care.
- XII. Metal utensils, or any other item that could be considered or used as a weapon.
- XIII. Drones of any kind (see Drone Policy)

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

A. DRONES OF ANY KIND

In order to ensure the safety, security, privacy, and property interests of the Yuba-Sutter Fairgrounds, the use of drones is strictly prohibited within the Fairgrounds property and/or air space without prior written consent. Violators may be subject to removal and/or arrest.

B. BICYCLES AND WHEELED DEVICES

Skateboards, hoverboards, foot-powered scooters, Roller Skates, shoes with wheels in the soles, and similar types of wheeled transportation other than Other Power-Driven Mobility Devices (OPDMD) are not permitted inside the Fairgrounds. (*wagons and strollers are permitted upon screening)

C. SERVICE ANIMAL & PETS

The only animals allowed on the grounds are service animals and animals on exhibit or used in entertainment.

Service dogs are welcome at the Fair, but “comfort animals” do not qualify under the ADA guidelines from the Department of Justice and will not be allowed into the Fair. Pets are not allowed on the fairgrounds, with the exception of service animals and animals approved as part of an exhibition. The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) defines a service animal as an animal that has been individually trained to do work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability. The task(s) performed by the animal must be directly related to the person’s disability. Animals whose sole function is to provide protection, comfort or emotional support do not qualify as service animals under the ADA and are not allowed on the fairgrounds.

D. SMOKING AND/OR VAPING

Smoking and/or vaping is only allowed in the designated areas throughout the Fairgrounds. Individuals who violate this policy may be removed from the venue.

E. INAPPROPRIATE ATTIRE

Fair management may refuse entry to guests wearing attire which could create a distraction, safety risk, and/or who are not properly attired. All clothing should be family friendly. Guests are required to remain fully clothed at all times.

Prohibited attire includes:

- Face coverings or masks (*exemptions are possible for religious , medical and health purposes)
- Clothing displaying offensive messages. Language, and/or images.
- Transparent clothing
- Clothing that exposes inappropriate portions of the body, such as string bikini tops, G-string, bikini bottoms, etc.
- Clothing that identifies the wearer as part of a gang or club.
