General Show Information & Rules

1. The Show Management reserves the right to limit the number of entries. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Early entry is *highly recommended*.
2. Exhibitors must be 21 years or younger as of January 1, 2024 to be eligible to enter and show.
3. No smoking will be allowed in the barn area.
4. The fairgrounds reserves the right to remove any competitor or spectator for any conduct that reflects poorly on the event.
5. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal to show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.
6. The Management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
7. Any animal exhibiting signs of an infectious or unsightly condition will not be permitted to show.
8. Any animal that is deemed a safety hazard by show management will be disqualified with no refund.
9. No dogs will be allowed around the show ring area.
10. Out of State exhibitors must provide show management the appropriate health inspections and brand inspections at the time of check-in.
11. All Livestock Trailers that do not have a "Show out of the Trailer" pre-paid space must park in the North Parking Lot, which is located on the far north end of the fairgrounds.

Entry Information

1. Online entry due date is Wednesday, March 6th.
2. Late entries will be accepted up to March 13th with a \$40 per entry added late fee.
3. Entry Fees:
 - a. Heifer Show: \$60 per entry
 - b. Steer Show: \$60 per entry
 - c. Market Heifer Show: \$60 per entry
 - d. Beef Showmanship: \$25 per entry
4. Entries available online at the Showman's App, showman.app/shows
5. No refunds will be available.

Arrival Deadlines

1. Cattle may start arriving on Friday, March 15th starting at 9 am. No early arrivals will be allowed.
2. All Registered Heifers must be onsite and registration papers and ear tattoo checked by 5 pm on Friday March 15th.
3. All Commercial Heifers must be onsite and weighed in by 5 pm on Friday March 15th.
4. All Steers and Market Heifers must be onsite, in place and weighed in by 5 pm Saturday, March 16th.

Stalling in the Barns

1. Complimentary shavings will not be provided by the fairgrounds. Exhibitors may bring and utilize their own shavings. Shavings will be available for purchase at the show. Straw bedding will not be allowed.
2. Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning the stall area prior to departure.
3. There will be no pre-assigned stalls. Exhibitors may choose their own tie area on a first come-first served basis.
4. We kindly ask that you clean up your barn tie area including, bedding, trash, feed and manure prior to your departure.
5. Power is limited in the barns. Highly recommended to bring generators as an alternate source of power. Generators must be placed outside of the barns when in use.

Show Out of Trailer Information

1. All livestock trailers that want to park in the grass areas inside the perimeter of the fairgrounds must purchase a "Show out of the Trailer Space." Trailers will not be permitted to park in the grass areas without pre-paying for the space.
2. Cost is \$75 for the weekend with no Electrical Hook ups and \$130 with electrical hook ups. Available online at the time of entering the jackpot show.
3. We kindly ask that you clean up your show out of trailer area including bedding, trash, feed and manure prior to your departure.

Weigh-in Information

1. All Steers, Market Heifers, Commercial Heifers must be weighed-in for weight classification.
2. Commercial Heifers must be weighed-in by Friday March 15th by 5 pm.
3. Steers & Market Heifers must be weighed in by Saturday March 16th by 5 pm.

Heifer Show Information

1. All heifers must be in place, papers checked-in by 5:00 pm Friday March 15th.
2. Heifers are eligible to show in both Show A and Show B. You must enter each show if you wish to compete in both shows. The heifer shows will take place on Saturday, March 16th. Ring A will start at 9:00 am. Ring B will start at the conclusion of the first heifer division in Ring A.
3. Registered Heifers and Commercial Heifers showing in the Heifer Show on Saturday ARE eligible to show in the Market Heifer show on Sunday.

REGISTERED HEIFER SHOW

4. All registered heifers must be registered in the exhibitor's name only. The registration papers must be presented at the time of check-in. Ear Tattoo number's will be checked.
5. Purebred Registered Heifers must be shown in the breed division that they are registered in if that breed division is available at the show. See below for the available breed divisions.
6. The Registered Heifer Show will include the following breed divisions:
 - Angus
 - Hereford
 - Miniature Hereford
 - Shorthorn
 - ❖ Only Purebred Shorthorn Heifers are eligible to show in the Shorthorn Division. Appendix Shorthorn Heifers must be entered and showed in the All Other Breeds Division.
 - Charolais
 - Maine Anjou/Maintainer
 - Chi-Maine/Chi X
 - Simmental/Simmental %
 - All Other Breeds

REGISTERED HEIFER SHOW AWARDS & PAYOUTS

- a. The Top 3 Heifers from each breed division will be awarded the following.
 - i. Breed Division Champion: \$100 and a Top 3 Banner
 - ii. Reserve Breed Champion: \$50 and a Top 3 Banner
 - iii. 3rd Overall in Breed: Top 3 Banner
- b. The Overall Top 5 Heifers in each show will be awarded a banner and the Overall Supreme & Reserve Supreme Heifers will receive a special award.
 - i. Supreme Champion Heifer: \$750 plus a Belt Buckle and a Top 5 Banner
 - ii. Reserve Supreme Champion Heifer: \$400 plus a Belt Buckle and a Top 5 Banner
 - iii. 3rd Overall: \$200 and a Top 5 Banner
 - iv. 4th Overall: \$100 and a Top 5 Banner
 - v. 5th Overall: \$50 and a Top 5 Banner

BRED & OWNED HEIFER SHOW

7. The Registered Heifer show will include a Bred & Owned Heifer Class for each breed division and an Overall Top 5 Bred & Owned Heifers.
8. You must enter the Bred & Owned Class if you wish to compete in the class. The Bred & Owned Show will **only** be available in **Show A**. In order to compete in the Bred & Owned heifer class you must have entered and shown the heifer in the regular heifer show.

9. Commercial Heifers are not eligible to compete in the Bred & Owned Heifer Show.

BRED & OWNED AWARDS & PAYOUTS

- a. The Top 2 Bred & Owned heifers from each breed division will be awarded a banner and premium money.
 - Bred & Owned Breed Division Champion: \$100 and a Banner
 - Bred & Owned Reserve Breed Division Champion: \$50 and a Banner
- b. The Top 2 Bred & Owned from each breed division will compete for the Overall Supreme Champion, Reserve Supreme Champion.
- c. The Overall Top 5 Bred & Owned Heifers will be awarded a banner and premium money.
 - i. Supreme Champion Bred & Owned Heifer: \$350 plus a Belt Buckle and a Banner
 - ii. Reserve Supreme Champion Bred & Owned Heifer: \$200 plus a Belt Buckle and a Banner
 - iii. 3rd Overall: \$100 and a Banner
 - iv. 4th Overall: \$75 and a Banner
 - v. 5th Overall: \$50 and a Banner

COMMERCIAL HEIFER SHOW

10. The Commercial Heifer Show is for non-registered/grade heifers ONLY. Registered Heifers are not eligible to compete in the Commercial heifer division.
11. Commercial Heifers must be weighed-in.
12. Commercial Heifers must be on-site and weighed-in by Friday, March 15th by 5 pm.
13. The classes will be divided by weight classification.
14. The Champion & Reserve Champion and 3rd Overall Commercial Heifer **are eligible** to compete for Supreme Champion Heifer and Top 5 Overall Heifers.

COMMERCIAL HEIFER AWARDS & PAYOUTS

- a. The Top 3 Commercial Heifers will be awarded the following.
 - i. Champion Commercial Heifer: \$100 and a banner
 - ii. Reserve Champion Commercial Heifer: \$50 and a Banner
 - iii. 3rd Overall Commercial Heifer: Banner

THE BEST OF YUBA-SUTTER HEIFER SHOW

1. Must be a resident of Yuba or Sutter County,
2. Must be a member of Yuba or Sutter County 4-H, FFA, or Grange club/chapter.
3. All heifers will show together in one class.
4. The Champion Best of Yuba-Sutter Heifer will receive a banner and cash award.
5. The show will take place following the Supreme Champion Heifer Drives in Ring A.

Steer Show Information

1. All Steers must be onsite and weighed in by 5 p.m. on Saturday March 16th.
2. All Steers must be weighed in for weight classification. Steer Weigh in's will take place on Friday and Saturday. Check the schedule for times.
3. Steers are eligible to show in both Show A and Show B. You must enter each show if you wish to compete in both shows. The steer shows will take place on Sunday, March 17th. Ring A will start at 9:00 a.m. Ring B will start at the conclusion of the first steer division in Ring A.
4. Divisions & Classes will be divided by weight after weigh-in. There will be two weight divisions, Division I and Division II. An Overall Champion Steer, Reserve Champion Steer and 3rd, 4th, 5th overall steer will be selected from each weight division.
5. British Color Classified Steers will be classified by color and are not required to be registered by any breed association.
6. The steer show will offer three color divisions:
 - a. British (Registered Shorthorn, Angus, Hereford Steers– to be shown together)
 - b. All Other Color (AOC)
 - c. Black/Black X

THE BEST OF YUBA-SUTTER STEER SHOW

1. Must be a resident of Yuba or Sutter County,
2. Must be a member of Yuba or Sutter County 4-H, FFA, or Grange club/chapter.
3. All steers will show together in one class.
4. The Champion Best of Yuba-Sutter Steer will receive a banner and cash award.
5. The show will take place following the Supreme Champion Steer Drives in Ring A.

Market Heifer Show Information

1. All Market Heifers must be onsite and weighed in by 5 p.m. on Saturday March 16th.
2. Registered Heifers and Commercial Heifers showing in the Heifer Show on Saturday ARE eligible to show in the market heifer show on Sunday.
3. All Market Heifers must be weighed in for weight classification. Market Heifer Weigh in's will take place on Friday and Saturday. Check the schedule for times.
4. The Market Heifer show will not be broken by color, **ONLY** by weight. There will be one division. An Overall Champion Market Heifer, Reserve Champion Market Heifer and 3rd, 4th, 5th Overall Market Heifers will be selected.
5. The Champion & Reserve Champion Market Heifers and the Overall 3rd, 4th and 5th are eligible to compete for the Supreme Champion & Overall Top 5 Market Animal.
6. The Top 5 Market Heifers will be awarded the following.
 - a. Champion Market Heifer: \$200 and a Banner
 - b. Reserve Champion Market Heifer: \$100 and a Banner
 - c. 3rd Overall Market Heifer: \$75 and a Banner
 - d. 4th Overall Market Heifer: \$50 and a Banner
 - e. 5th Overall Market Heifer: \$25 and a Banner

Showmanship Information

1. There will be two days of showmanship competition. You must enter each day if you wish to compete in both showmanship competitions. The judges will switch showrings on Saturday & Sunday to allow exhibitors to be evaluated by a different judge for each day of the showmanship competitions.
2. The winner from each of the showmanship divisions will compete in the Greatest of All the Showmen Class and be awarded a belt buckle and cash prize!
3. Cattle Showmanship ages will be based on the age of the exhibitor as of January 1, 2024.
4. Age Divisions will include:
 - i. Novice Beef Showmanship: Ages 4 to 8
 - ii. Junior Beef Showmanship: Ages 9-12
 - iii. Intermediate Beef Showmanship: Ages 13-16
 - iv. Senior Beef Showmanship: Ages 17-21
5. All exhibitors must show their own heifer or steer. All animals showed in showmanship must be entered in a steer or heifer class by the same exhibitor. Heifers and Steers are eligible to be shown in both days of the showmanship competitions.
6. Fitting is optional for showmanship.
7. The Showmanship competition will take place approximately 45 minutes from the conclusion of the show.
8. Banners, Buckle Awards & Payouts will include:
 - a. The Top 5 from each age division will be awarded a banner.
 - b. The Champion Showman from each age division will be awarded a buckle.
 - c. Premium payouts will be awarded to the Top 5 from each age division and to the Supreme Champion "Greatest of All The Showmen"
