General Show Information & Rules

1. The Show Management reserves the right to limit the number of entries. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Early entry is **highly recommended**.
2. The Show Management reserves the right to make changes that will better accommodate and/or improve the show. Management reserves the final and absolute right to interpret the following rules and regulations and to arbitrarily settle questions and differences thereto or otherwise arising out of, or connected with, or pertaining to the Clash for Cash Sheep and Goat Show.
3. Exhibitors must be 21 years or younger as of January 1, 2024 to be eligible to enter and show.
4. No smoking will be allowed in the barn area.
5. The fairgrounds reserves the right to remove any competitor or spectator for any conduct that reflects poorly on the event.
6. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal to show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.
7. The Management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
8. Any animal exhibiting signs of an infectious or unsightly condition will not be permitted to show.
9. Any animal that is deemed a safety hazard by show management will be disqualified with no refund.
10. No dogs will be allowed around the show ring area.
11. Out of State exhibitors must provide show management the appropriate health inspections at the time of check-in.
12. All Livestock Trailers that do not have a "Show out of the Trailer" pre-paid space must park in the North Parking Lot, which is located on the far north end of the fairgrounds.
13. To be eligible for the Best of Yuba-Sutter Division you must have showed in the open jackpot show. Also you must be a resident of either Yuba or Sutter County.

Entry Information

1. Online entry due date is Wednesday, April 10th.
2. Late entries will be accepted up to April 17th with a \$25 per entry added late fee.
3. Last day to submit late entries is Wednesday, April 17th. Entries will **not** be accepted after April 17th.
4. Entry Fees:
 - a. Sheep Show: \$50 per entry
 - b. Goat Show: \$50 per entry
 - c. Showmanship: \$25 per entry

6. No refunds will be available.

Arrival Deadlines

1. Sheep and Goats may start arriving on Friday, April 19th starting at 8 am
2. All Sheep & Goats must be onsite, weighed-in and in place by Friday, April 19th at 5 pm.

Stalling in the Barns

1. Complimentary shavings will not be provided by the fairgrounds. Exhibitors may bring and utilize their own shavings. Shavings will be available for purchase at the show. Straw bedding will not be allowed.
2. Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning the stall area prior to departure. Please use designated dump area.
3. There will be no pre-assigned stalls. Exhibitors may choose their own stalls on a first come-first served basis.
4. We kindly ask that you clean up your barn area including, bedding, trash, feed and manure prior to your departure.
5. Power is limited in the barns. Highly recommended to bring generators as an alternate source of power. Generators must be placed outside of the barns when in use.

Show Out of Trailer Information

1. All livestock trailers that want to park in the grass areas inside the perimeter of the fairgrounds must purchase a "Show out of the Trailer Space." Trailers will not be permitted to park in the grass areas without pre-paying for the space.
2. Cost is \$75 for the weekend with no Electrical Hook ups and \$130 with electrical hook ups. Available online at the time of entering the jackpot show.
3. We kindly ask that you clean up your show out of trailer area including bedding, trash, feed and manure prior to your departure.

Weigh-in Information

1. All Lambs and Goats must be weighed-in for weight classification.
2. Lambs and Wether Dam Ewes must be weighed in by Friday, April 19th from 2 pm to 6 pm.
3. Goats and Wether Dam Does must be weighed in by Friday, April 19th from 2 pm to 6 pm.

Sheep Show Information

1. All Sheep must be onsite and in place on Friday, April 19th by 6 pm.
2. Wether Dam Ewes can be dual entered in the jackpot show/Wether Dam Ewe show.
3. Wether Dam Ewes will be evaluated as breeding animals.
4. Wether Dam Ewes must have milk teeth or yearling teeth.
5. Wether Dam Ewes must have an ear tag or permanent legible tattoo, prior to weigh in.
6. All Sheep must be weighed in for weight classification. Sheep Weigh in will take place on Friday, April 19th. Check the schedule for times.
7. Sheep are eligible to show in both Show A and Show B. You must enter each show if you wish to compete in both shows. The sheep shows will take place on Saturday, April 20th and Sunday, April 21st. Check schedule for times.
8. Divisions & Classes will be divided by weight after weigh in. There will be two weight divisions. Prospect & Progress. An Overall Champion Lamb, Reserve Champion Lamb and 3rd overall lamb will be selected from each color division.
9. The sheep show will offer three color divisions:
 - a. Speck/Whiteface
 - b. Natural
 - c. Blackface
10. Banners & Special Awards will include:
 - a. Prospect - Top 3 Lambs from each color division will be awarded a banner.
 - b. Progress – Top 3 Lambs from each color division will be awarded a banner.
 - c. Top 3 Champion Overall Color Divisions.
 - d. The Overall Top 5 from the Supreme Drive will be awarded a banner. The Supreme & Reserve Supreme Lamb will receive a special award.
11. Champion & Top 5 Cash Payouts will include:
 - a. Prospect
 - i. Top 3 Lambs from each color Division will receive the following: Prospect Champion: \$75, Reserve Prospect Champion: \$50, 3rd Overall Prospect: \$25
 - b. Progress

Goat Show Information

1. All Goats must be onsite and in place on Friday, April 19th by 6 pm.
2. Wether Dam Does can be dual entered in the jackpot show/Wether Dam Doe show.
3. Wether Dam Does will be evaluated as breeding animals.
4. Wether Dam Does must have milk teeth or yearling teeth.
5. Wether Dam Does must have an ear tag or permanent legible tattoo, prior to weigh in.
6. Wether Dam Does may be shown with or without horns.
7. Wether Dam Does may be shown with or without being slick shorn.
8. All Market Goats and Wether Dam Does must be weighed in for weight classification. Goat weigh in will take place on Friday, April 19th. Check the schedule for times.
9. Goats are eligible to show in both Show A and Show B. You must enter each show if you wish to compete in both shows. The goat shows will take place on Saturday, April 20th and Sunday, April 21st. Check schedule for times.
10. Divisions & Classes will be divided by weight after weigh in. There will be two weight divisions, Division I & Division II.
11. Banners & Special Awards will include:
 - a. Division I - Top 3 Goats from each division will be awarded a banner.
 - b. Division II - Top 3 Goats from each division will be awarded a banner.
 - c. The Overall Top 5 from the Supreme Drive will be awarded a banner. The Supreme & Reserve Supreme Goat will receive a special award.
12. Champion & Top 5 Cash Payouts will include:
 - a. Division I –
 - i. Top 3 Goats from each Division will receive the following: Champion Overall Division I Goat: \$250, Reserve Overall Division I Goat: \$150, 3rd Overall Division I Goat: \$100
 - b. Division II –
 - i. Top 3 Goats from each Division will receive the following: Champion Overall Division II Goat: \$250, Reserve Overall Division II Goat: \$150, 3rd Overall Division II Goat: \$100
 - c. Supreme Champion Market Goat: \$500, Reserve Supreme Champion Market Goat: \$300, 3rd Overall Market Goat: \$150, 4th Overall Market Goat: \$100, 5th Overall Market Goat: \$50.
 - d. Wether Dam Does

- i. Top 3 Wether Dam Does from each Division will receive the following: Lightweight Champion: \$75, Lightweight Reserve Champion: \$50, 3rd Overall Lightweight: \$25
 - ii. Top 3 Wether Dam Does from each Division will receive the following: Heavyweight Champion: \$75, Heavyweight Reserve Champion: \$50, 3rd Overall Heavyweight: \$25
- e. Supreme Champion Wether Dam Doe: \$500, Reserve Supreme Champion Wether Dam Doe: \$300, 3rd Overall Wether Dam Doe: \$150, 4th Overall Wether Dam Doe: \$100, 5th Overall Wether Dam Doe: \$50.

Showmanship Information

There will be two days of showmanship competition for Hogs, Sheep and Goats. You must enter each day if you wish to compete in both showmanship competitions. The judges will switch showings on Saturday & Sunday to allow exhibitors to be evaluated by a different judge for each day of the showmanship competitions.

1. Showmanship ages will be based on the age of the exhibitor as of January 1, 2024.
2. Age Divisions will include:
 - a. Novice Showmanship: Ages 8 and under
 - b. Junior Showmanship: Ages 9-12
 - c. Intermediate Showmanship: Ages 13-16
 - d. Senior Showmanship: Ages 17-21
3. All exhibitors must show their own hog, lamb and goat.
4. All animals shown in showmanship must be entered in a hog, lamb and goat class by the same exhibitor.
5. Fitting is optional for showmanship.
6. Banners & Buckle Awards will include:
 - a. The Top 5 from each age division will be awarded a banner.
 - b. The Champion Showman from each age division will be awarded a buckle.
